

New Year's Masters Ski Jumping Tournament

Lake Placid NY – Dec 29, 2011

This year the New Year's Masters event was contested using the "Soaring Saturday" format. Under this format each jumper jumps twice in bib order with distance only being recorded. Five meters are deducted for lack of a telemark landing and/or for a touch. A fall results in a zero. Each jumper's best score out of the two jumps is used to rank all jumpers with the top one half moving on to a third round. Each jumper's third round distance is then added to his/her best distance from the first two rounds for the final results. Jumpers pick their gate. Here are the results after the first two rounds :

The third round is run in reverse order and produced the following final results:

1. Nick Fairall 96 meters for a total score of 190.5
2. Alex Madden 93 meters for a total score of 188
3. Will Schott 95 meters for a total score of 187
4. Cooper Dodds and Andre Denney tied with 90.5 meters for total of 180
5. Colin Delaney 90.5 meters for a total of 179.5
6. Trevor Edlund 90.5 meters for a total of 177
7. Trevor Wert 86.5 meters for a total of 176.5
8. Luke Daniels 88 meters for a total of 176
9. Nick Mattoon 91.5 distance minus 10 for lack of a tele and for a drag for a net 81.5 and total of 169.5
10. Andrew Bliss 102 distance but with a fall that resulted in a net 0 for a total of 96
