



13th Annual North American Springer Tournee & US Championships

Utah Olympic Park

Park City, Utah

July 25 – 30th, 2011

GENERAL INFO –

The 13th Annual Springer Tournee Series is a set of two events on each size ski jump, in which top Junior and Senior Ski Jumpers and Nordic Combined athletes from all over North America compete. Athletes are awarded points based on the FIS Tournee scoring system for their placing in each event. After the two events on each hill, an overall winner is crowned the Jindro Mayer Springer Tournee Champion for each hill.

Overall awards 1-3 in each J class, and Nordic combined will be given out after the second competition on all hills at an awards ceremony Saturday afternoon at the Utah Olympic Park.

COMPETITION FORMAT:

The first and second events on all hills will be normal J class events, as well as Nordic Combined. Nordic Combined awards will be given off of the first competition on the small hills up to J-3. J2- J1 NC awards will be given off of the second set of competitions Friday. Any questions, please contact Alan Alborn.

For the HS-100 events, all registered skiers will be granted one trial round, and one competition jump.

**For the second round, the competition(s) will be cut to the top 30 athletes from the first round jump due to length of competition in the evening.*

To qualify for Saturday's HS-134 Long Standing event, the top 13 men and top three women skiing in the open class from Thursday's (HS-100) event will be eligible for the Long Standing exhibition during the Festival of Flight. The exhibition will be a knock out event with the skiers jumping head to head until the last two skiers jump for the title. Max five rounds will allowed due to Festival of Flight activities and the day's schedule.

The Nordic Combined events will consist of one jumping event, and one cross-country running event J3 and younger and roller skiing for J1/J2 (J2 depending on coaches discretion). The Nordic Combined events will be Gundersen start format, Nordic combined results will be calculated using the first jumping competitions on all hills Tuesday and Wednesday. (J1- Open events will be run like a FIS event only using the 1st jump)

REGISTRATION: Please pre-register using the official registration document included with the invitation. An athlete is only allowed to enter a **MAXIMUM OF 3 HILLS, PLUS ONE NORDIC COMBINED EVENT.**

REGISTRATION FEES:

Springer Tournee SMALL HILLS (Ages 13 and under HS-15 – HS-45) \$65.00 for all events and two included dinners: Monday July 25th and Saturday July 30th.
(Hill Fees separate on open training days)

Springer Tournee LARGE HILLS (Ages 14 and older HS-70 –HS-100) \$70.00 for all events and two included dinners: Monday July 25th and Saturday July 30th. If an athlete will be entering in the US Championships as well as Springer Tournee the entry fee will be \$100.00 for the week.
(Hill Fees separate on open training days)

Springer Tournee LARGE HILL & US Championships (Ages 14 and older HS-70 –HS-134) \$100.00
Two included dinners: Monday July 25th and Saturday July 30th. If an athlete will be entering in the US Championships as well as Springer Tournee the entry fee will be \$100.00 for the week.
(Hill Fees separate on open training days)

US CHAMPIONSHIPS ONLY (HS-134) \$75.00

The HS-134 US Championship event is separate from the Springer Tournee.
(Hill Fees separate on open training days)



TRAINING FEE: UOP Hill use fees/lift fees will be required in addition to registration fees for all open training days. Hill use fees/Lift fees are as follows:

HS-15 – HS-45 (small hills) \$12 per day
HS-70 – HS-134 (large hills) \$20 per day

You may decide to purchase a season's pass from the Utah Olympic Park for \$250 (Large hills HS-70 – HS-134) or \$125 for (Small hills HS-15- HS-45). Please complete the Utah Olympic Park waiver when you arrive at the Guest Services desk, 1st floor of the Museum at the Utah Olympic Park. Please be ready to have a parent or guardian sign this waiver for athletes under 18 years of age. Athletes must also provide current medical/health insurance policy information. You will need to give the completed form to the athlete desk to receive a lift pass.

WAXING/CHANGING FACILITIES:

Each team will be provided the appropriate changing areas/waxing facilities. Please check with the PCNSC office to find out where your team's facilities are located when you arrive. Please respect other team's space and utilize only your teams' facility for waxing and changing. *Please only PCNSC/WSJUSA/USASJ team athletes will be allowed to use the Ski Jump Center waxing/changing facilities for the large hills side (HS-70 – HS134)*
